Hawaii Information Consortium General Manager's Report

JANUARY - FEBRUARY 2014

Executive Summary

We closed a phenomenal 2013 with 12 local and national awards, 15 press releases, 22 new services, 6 new websites, 13 mobile applications and 23 major service upgrades. We look to 2014 to be a year to set new records. As of the beginning of March, we have completed all of the 2014 Tax filing year changes for both eFile and MEF services, setting a new stage for all PVL licensees, we launched two new mobile responsive services, as well as a major upgrade for the Real Estate Education System.

Marketing Activity

DCCA BREG

The New Year kicks off a new annual filing quarter. 22,546 annual reminder cards and 18,597 emails were sent to the filers at the beginning of January 2014.

DCCA PVL Division

3,248 reminder cards were mailed to the licenses from the Medical and Osteopathy Board, who are due to renew their licenses by January 31, 2014.

DCCA INS Division

6,239 reminder cards and 4,853 emails were sent to the licenses that are due to renew by April 16, 2014.

Office of Election

Portal has responded to an RFI for the Office of Election regarding the Electronic Voter Registration Systems.

Judiciary

New round of Appellate Court Judge Evaluation was kicked off in January through a online survey process.

Highlights

Department of Taxation

The year-end updates for 2013 filing period were completed and launched on schedule on January 2, 2014. Coinciding with the Federal tax filing portal opening of 2014 filing season, the Modernized eFile service update for 2014 was also enabled. As of late January, the portal had already processed over 185,000 personal income tax returns, enabling the Department of Taxation to set new records on the number and dollar amount, and shortened timeframe to issue refunds.

DCCA PVL Division

With the beta launch of the MyPVL dashboard, the December 2013 renewal cycle was ended on January 31, 2014. During the cycle, 25,830 (88%) licensees renewed online.

Real Estate Branch

The Real Estate Continuing Education system has been renamed to the Real Estate Education System with the additional of the Pre-licensing module. Now individuals who are interested in getting a real estate license can register online and receive credits for their pre-licensing courses, while schools can manage courses and attendees online. It also received a makeover with mobile responsive design and MyPVL integration.

MyPVL

The brand new service for all PVL licensees, MyPVL (pvl.hawaii.gov/mypvl) was launched on March 3, 2014. This page acts as the dashboard for all individual licensees. From the dashboard, licensees can access and manage licenses, complete renewal transactions, access continuing education information, apply for new licenses, and submit change requests. This service leverages the advances made as a result of the work on the my.hawaii.gov project. PVL is one of the first divisions to leverage the single-sign-on service.



Appendix C: Web Analytics Terms

- **Hit** - A request for a file from the web server. Available only in log analysis. The number of hits received by a website is frequently cited to assert its popularity, but this number is extremely misleading and dramatically over-estimates popularity. A single web-page typically consists of multiple (often dozens) of discreet files, each of which is counted as a hit as the page is downloaded, so the number of hits is really an arbitrary number more reflective of the complexity of individual pages on the website than the website's actual popularity. The total number of visitors or page views provides a more realistic and accurate assessment of popularity.
- **Page View** - A request for a file whose type is defined as a page in log analysis. An occurrence of the script being run in page tagging. In log analysis, a single page view generates multiple hits as all the resources required to view the page (images, .js and .css files) are also requested from the web server.
- **Visit / Session** - A series of requests from the same uniquely identified client with a set timeout. A visit is expected to contain multiple hits (in log analysis) and page views.
- **Visitor / Unique Visitor** - The uniquely identified client generating requests on the web server (log analysis) or viewing pages (page tagging). A visitor can make multiple visits.
